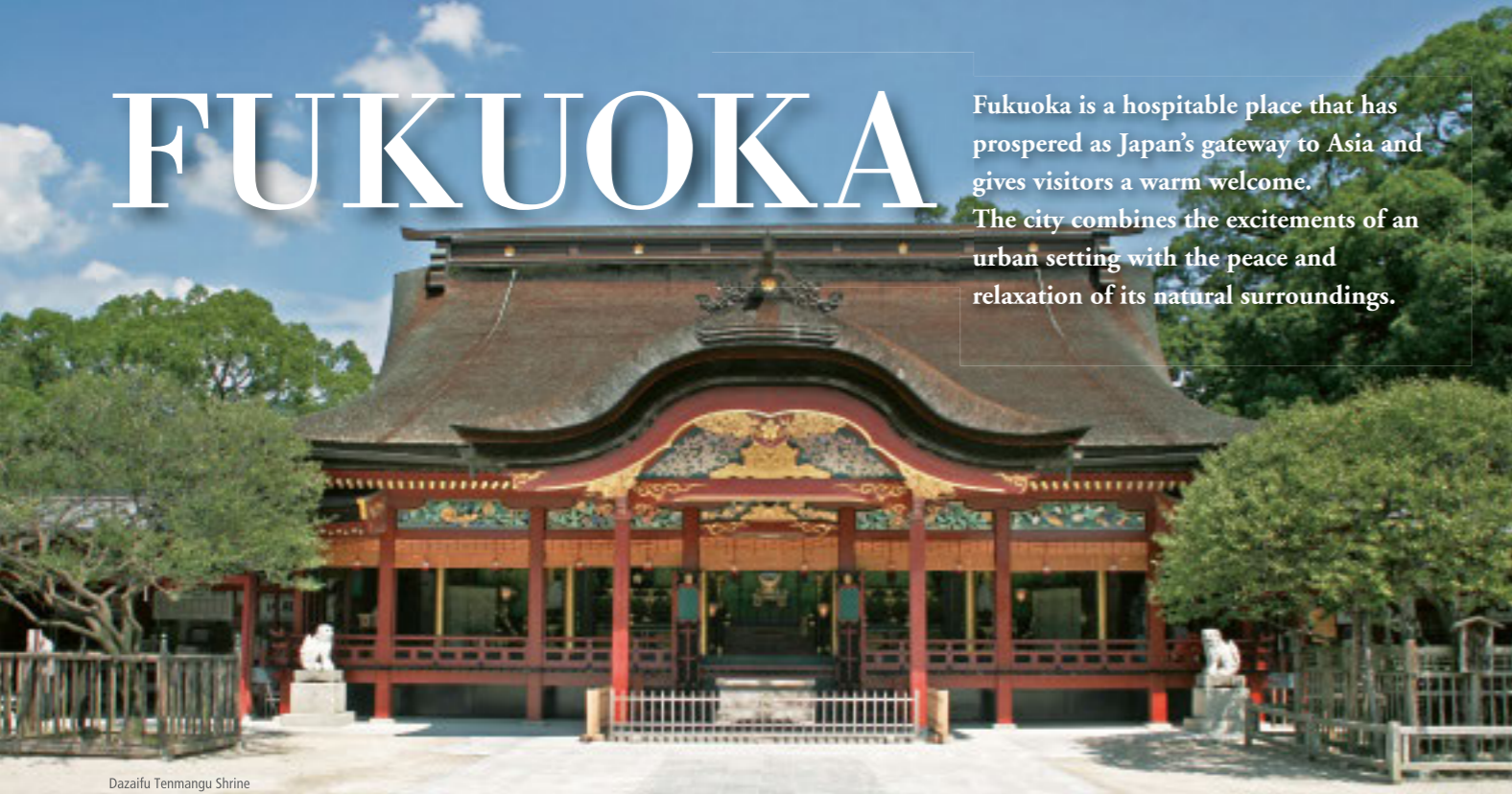

Hakata Kawabata Shopping Arcade is one of the oldest shopping districts in Fukuoka. 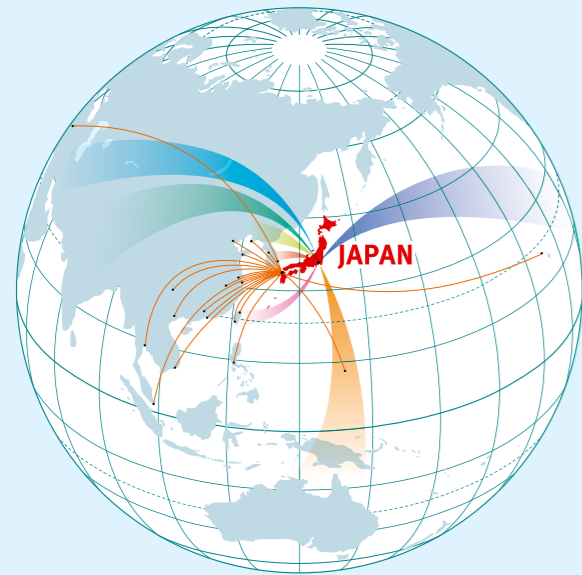
Close to the central train station, Hakata offers numerous hotels which are convenient for tourism and business.

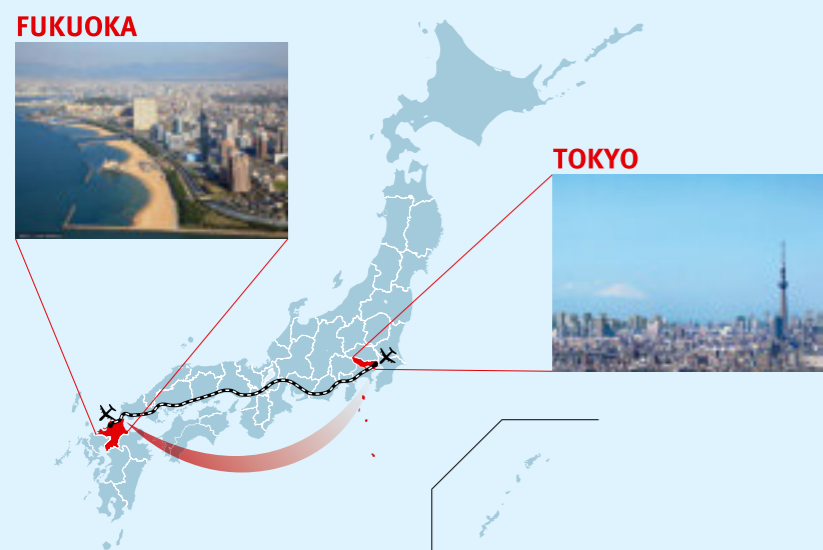
International Access

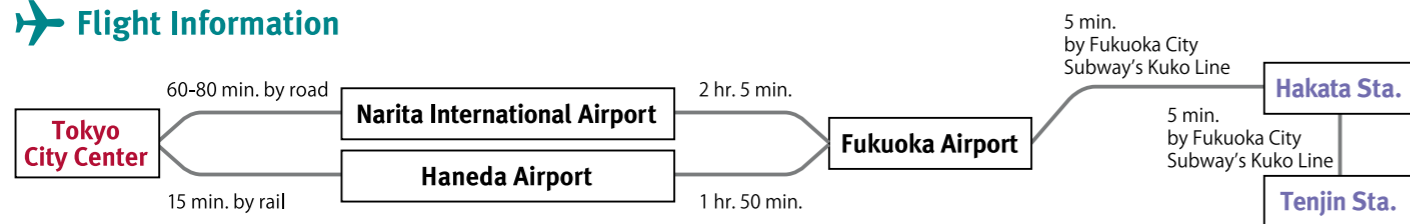


Frequent Domestic Flights between Tokyo and Fukuoka High-speed Shinkansen for Train Lovers

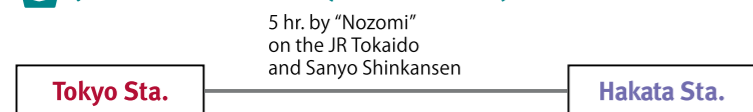
More than 60 flights a day connect Tokyo and Fukuoka in about two hours. The Shinkansen-Bullet trains run every half an hour or so, connecting these two cities in 5 hours, and gives the travelers chance to see more places on the way. Fukuoka's main train station, Hakata Station, lies between the Fukuoka Airport and the city center, Tenjin. It takes only 5 minutes by subway for both ways. Fukuoka, the largest city on the Kyushu island, stands as Japan's gateway city to Asia. A journey starting from Fukuoka can be a good option for the travelers from Asian countries. Enjoy the charms of two cities on a single itinerary.
